### WHAT YOU CAN DO

- Drop-Off items at dumpster (all dates)
- For those who need assistance\*: Curbside Pickup (May 9 only – call City Hall by May 6 to reserve pickup)
- Place items curbside by 9:00 AM on May 9

### NOT ACCEPTED

- Hazardous materials
- Tires
- Appliances
- Medical waste
- Yard debris
- Dirt/rock/concrete

\*Assistance available for those that do not have transportation for items and need curb side pickup assistance.

### REQUIREMENTS

- City residents only
- Must bring ID or utility bill for proof of residency to the City Public Works Shop dump location

### VOLUNTEERS

We are looking for volunteers to help with free curbside pickup for individuals who cannot bring items to the dumpster location. To volunteer please contact City Hall.
